



Road Captain Requirements

Maintain current and valid motorcycle driver's license

Maintain current and valid motorcycle insurance, with no less than the minimum required by the state for street riding purposes

MSF Experienced Riding Course Certification

Ability to train and fully understand Group Riding Skills

Tact and understanding of people – must be capable of managing conflict and getting along with your riders

Adherence to H.O.G.'s basic rules for Road Captains

*CPR Certification

*First Aid Certification

*Accident Scene Management Certification

All interested parties who have not completed Experienced Riding Course Certification will be considered Assistant Road Captains until that course has been completed. Assistants can lead rides if they are comfortable to do so..

*CPR, First Aid, Accident Scene Management and other “continuing education type programs will not be considered “mandatory” but will help our group become even more skilled and valued to the Chapter and for your own individual riding development.
